The Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) document will help you choose a health plan. The SBC shows you how you and the plan would share the cost for covered health care services. NOTE: Information about the cost of this plan (called the premium) will be provided separately. This is only a summary.

Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	\$500 individual / \$1,000 family (in-network). \$2,000 individual / \$4,000 family (out-of-network).	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, the overall family deductible must be met before the plan begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care and services with a copay are covered before you meet your deductible.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply.
Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You must pay all of the costs for these services up to the specific deductible amount before this plan begins to pay for these services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	\$4,000 individual / \$8,000 family (in-network). \$8,000 individual / \$16,000 family (out-of-network).	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	Premiums, balance-billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.
Will you pay less if you use a network provider?	Yes. This plan uses the Aetna Choice POS II Network. Call the number on your ID card for a list of network providers.	This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network. You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.

All coinsurance costs shown in this chart are after your deductible has been met, if a deductible applies.

	Preferred brand drugs (Tier 2)	\$35 copay (retail)	Not covered	30-day retail supply. 90-day mail order at 2.5x copay.
	Non-preferred brand drugs (Tier 3)	\$60 copay (retail)	Not covered	30-day retail supply.
	Specialty drugs (Tier 4)	\$100 copay	Not covered	Specialty pharmacy required.
If you have outpatient surgery	Facility fee (e.g., ambulatory surgery center)	20% coinsurance after deductible	40% coinsurance after deductible	Prior authorization required.

If you need immediate medical attention	Emergency room care	\$250 copay	\$250 copay	Copay waived if admitted.
